 - looking for manuf. that could assemble balsa, paper, fittings, etc - model companies, specialty toy manufacturer another comp that made radar chaff

 - no photographs of prototypes, etc - "cleaned house" about 10 yrs ago

- CALLED MRS DUFFY (COL DUFFY'S WIDOW) 13 JUN 94 TO DETERMINE IF SHE MIGHT HAVE ANY OF COL DUFFY'S OLD RECORDS/PAPERS
- SHE DID NOT KNOW ABOUT ANY OF THE SPECIFIC PROJECTS THAT HER HUSBAND HAD BEEN INVOLVED WITH IN 1947
- I EXPLAINED THAT WE WERE LOOKING FOR ANY RECORDS RELATED TO MOGUL, COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY, CAMBRIDGE LABS, OR NEW YORK UNIVERSITY PROJECTS AND ESPECIALLY RELATED TO ANY OFFICIAL COVER STORIES RELATED TO ANY PROJECTS HE MAY HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN
- MRS DUFFY INDICATED NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE ABOVE AND STATED THAT COL DUFFY DID HAVE "SEVERAL TRUNKS OF PAPERS AND STUFF" IN THE BASEMENT BUT SHE "HAD TO SELL THE HOUSE" AND HAD TO CLEAN OUT THE BASEMENT
 - APPROXIMATELY THREE MONTHS AGO SHE HIRED A COMMERCIAL HAULING COMPANY WHO PICKED UP THE "TRUNKS" FOR DISPOSAL; SHE DIDN'T THINK ANY OF THAT MATERIAL COULD BE FOUND AND DIDN'T BELIEVE IT WOULD DO ANY GOOD TO CONTACT THE COMPANY
- I CALLED HER BACK AND ASKED IF HER HUSBAND KEPT A PERSONAL DIARY, HE DIDN'T; HOWEVER, MRS DUFFY SAID THERE WAS ONE MORE FILE CABINET SHE HAD TO GO THROUGH THAT HAD SOME OF HIS PAPERS

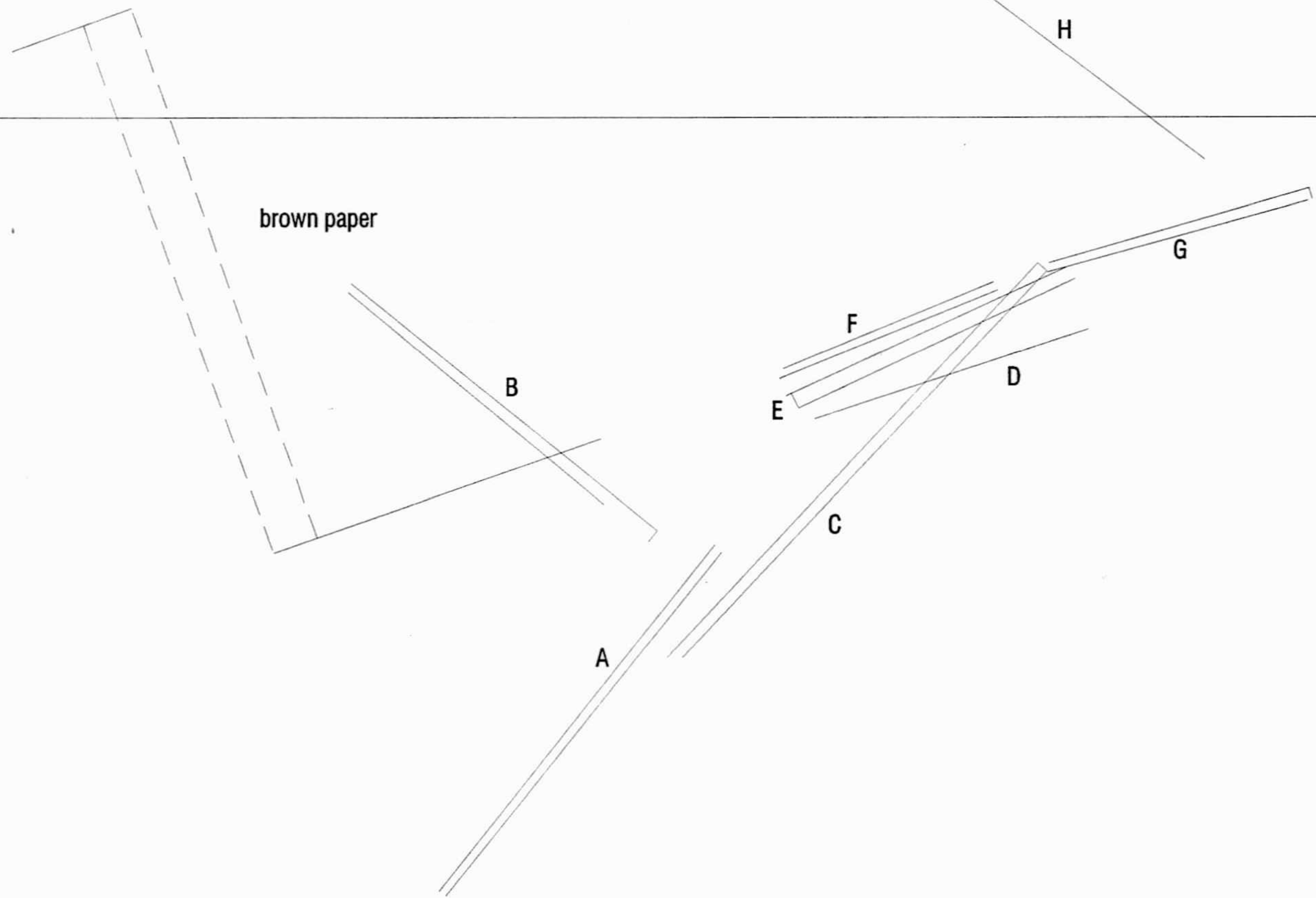
- Received a call from Mrs Emily Duffy

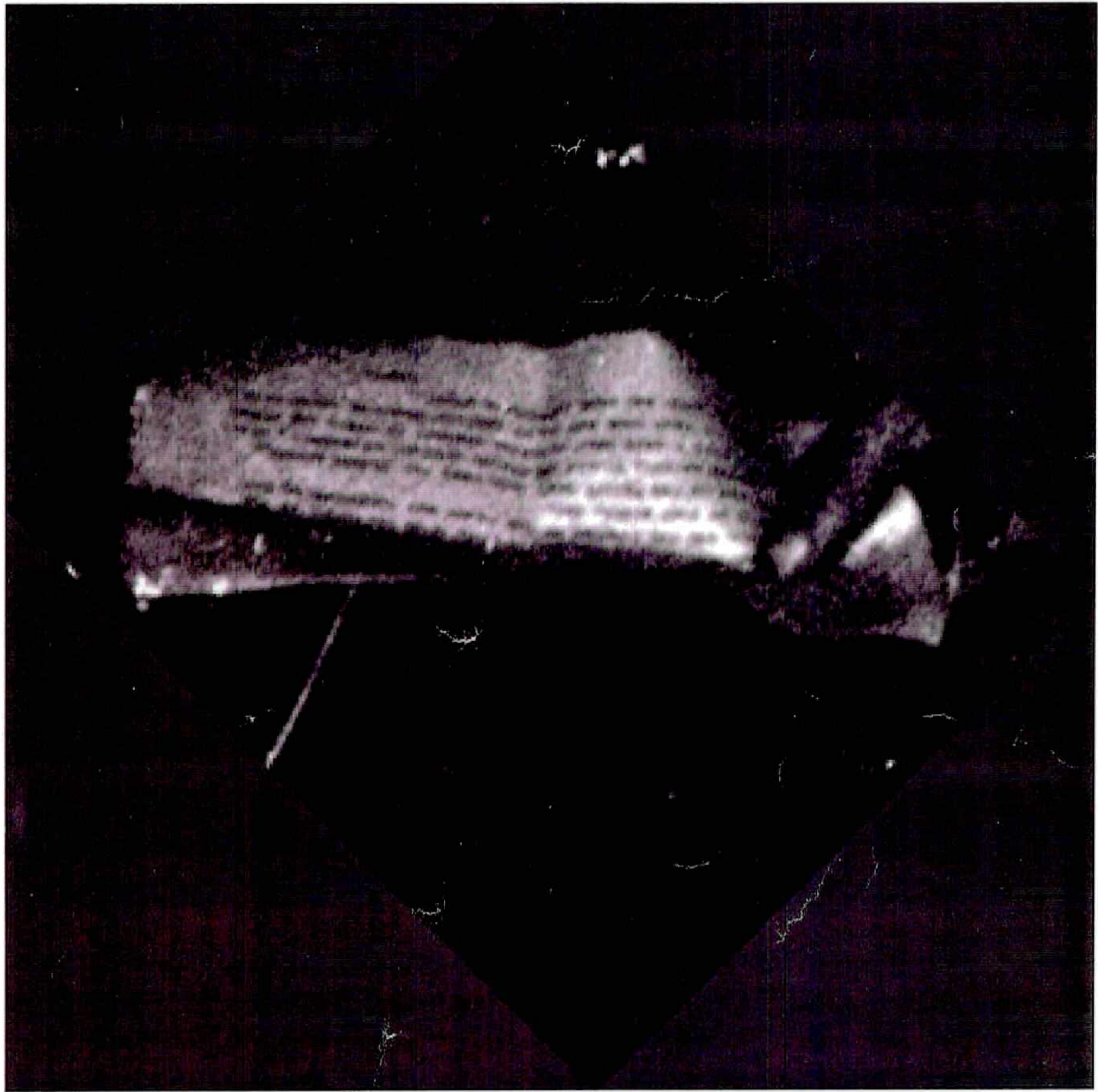

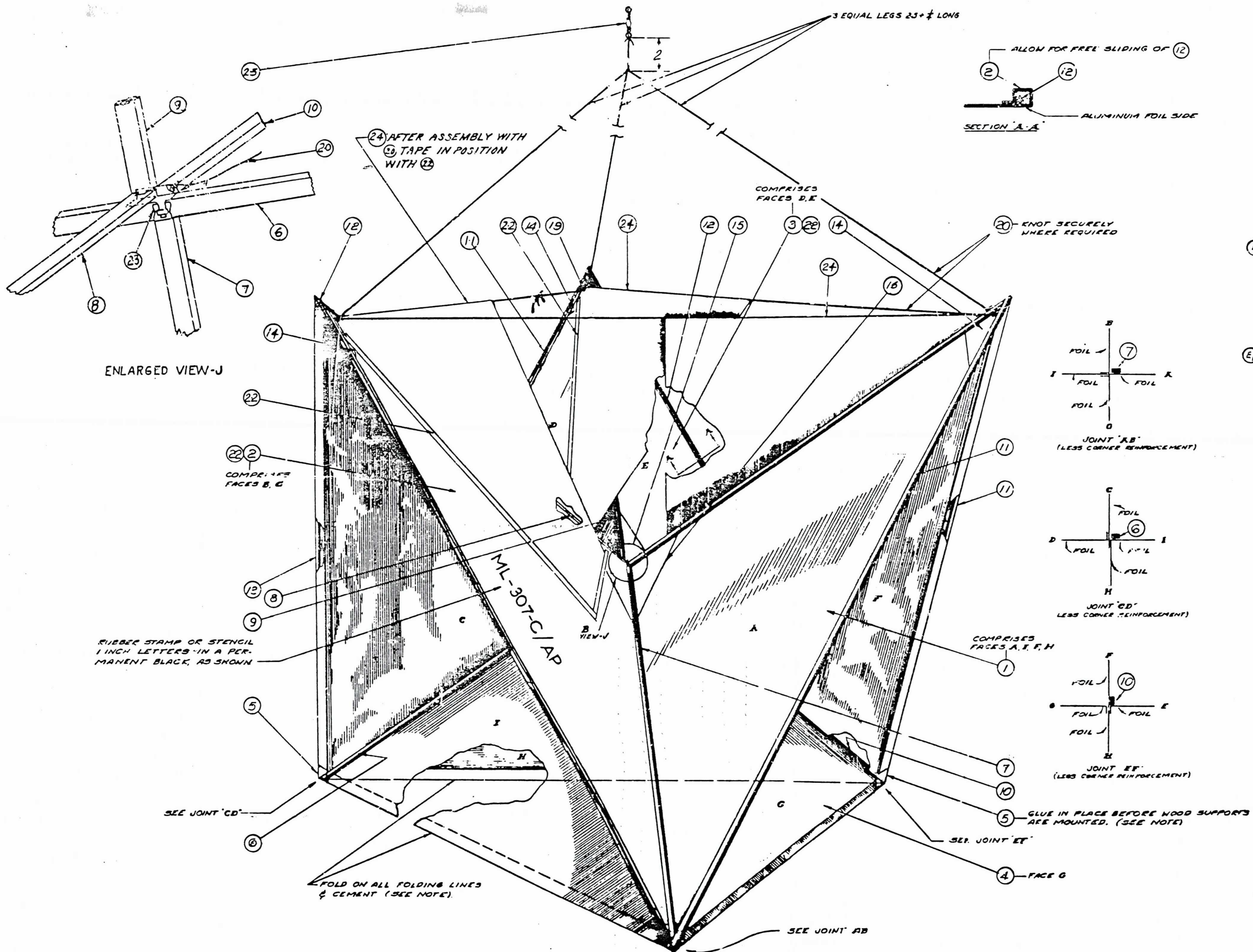
