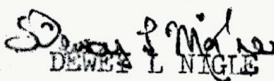

In compliance with AFR 200-2, dated 12 August 1954, Subject: Unidentified Flying Objects Reporting (Short Title: UFOB), the following report of referenced objects is submitted. On 15 November 1954, an Unidentified Flying Object (UFOB) was sighted by Mr. [REDACTED] of Baboquivari Park, Arizona while on a biological field expedition, 21 miles SSE of Baboquivari Park. The Object was a brilliant silver with an orange glow in color, round in shape, and had a discernible trail or exhaust from the bottom of the Object and from the cannon-like objects on top of the Object. The Object was traveling at a speed estimated by the observer to be six to seven hundred (600-700) miles per hour. Mr. [REDACTED] was equipped with Polaroid Land Camera and was able to obtain one picture of the Object. The preparing officer's knowledge of this subject was too scanty for full evaluation of the inclosed photograph.

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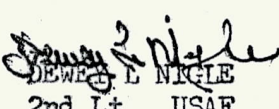
