

CG REPORT: 1200 - 21 Aug -- 0800 - 22 Aug

REMARKS:

1. Major Van Norman called at 2230 hours and gave the following information.

- a. At 2200 hours Major Van Norman was called by Capt Somenson, Duty Watch Officer, DCS/I, ADC. Capt Somenson stated he was called on a UFOB by Mrs [REDACTED]. Major Van Norman called Mrs [REDACTED] and she provided him with the following information.

(a) At 2040 hours she observed approximately fifteen (15) white lights in the sky, altitude unknown. The lights were about the size of a baseball and were traveling from South to North over her house. They changed direction once, turning to the right, got smaller and disappeared. The same lights came back about one half hour later in the same direction, shifted their position slightly, turned to the right, got smaller and disappeared again. Mrs [REDACTED] claimed that these lights were observed by her father and five (5) other neighbors. Major Van Norman called [REDACTED] and was informed that a DC-3 was flying in from Pueblo at 2030 hours, and had made a slight right hand turn over the city. Major Van Norman believed that the lights observed by Mrs [REDACTED] were those of the DC-3.
