WAS CIRCULAR IN SHAPE WITH LIGHT BEAMS OR RAYS RADIATING FROM IT, APPEARED MUCH LIKE A STAR, IT'S SIZE WAS COMPARED TO AN AIRCRAFT RECOGNITION LIGHT AT 2000 FT, WAS SAID TO BE A WHITE LIGHT WITH A LITTLE YELLOW, WAS FIRST SIGHTED DIRECTLY OVERHEAD AND MOVED EAST TO SOUTH EAST WITH LATERAL VARIATIONS UP TO TWENTY DEGREES.
