IT PASSED ABOVE US AT WHAT APPEARED TO BE 6 OR 8 THOU FT. THE LIGHTS WERE VERY MUCH BRIGHTER THAN ACFT CABIN LIGHTS. NO RUNNING LIGHTS, EXHAUST FLAME OR
