MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

1. Telephone conversation between A/IC R.D. DeRudder, Headquarters, 4602d AISS, and T/Sgt C.M. Howard, Flight 1-C, 4602d AISS.
2. The undersigned called Flight 1-C concerning the authorization of a follow-up UFOB investigation. It was requested that Flight 1-C investigate three (3) UFOB sightings from the Los Angeles area of 9 July 1955, all of which seem to be related by description and time of sighting.
3. It was suggested that Flight 1-C first make a thorough check with the local observatories for possible astronomical activities at the time of the sightings.
4. A limited telephonic investigation was requested of the UFOB sighting at Newport Beach, California, 9 July 1955.
