## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

- 1. Telephone conversation between A/IC DeRudder, Headquarters, 4602d AISS, and Captain Bischofs, Detachment 2, 4602d AISS.
- 2. Captain Bischofs called the undersigned concerning an investigation of the rash of UFOB sightings in Iowa during the past month. A check of observatories ascertained that all the sightings in question could probably be attributed to astronomical activity. Captain Bischofs stated that investigation revealed that many stars, especially during the fall, have the appearance of changing colors. Alternating red, green, white, and blue are the predominant colors changes.
- 3. It was requested that Detachment 2 investigate a UFOB sighting at Shelby, Iowa. Detachment 2 was informed that a copy of the UFOB report was available at CADF, Grandview AFB, Missouri.
- 4. Captain Bischofs informed the undersigned that at the present time they have a man on liaison in Towa and the possibility exists that he might be contacted to perform the investigation of this sighting. In the event that the man on liaison cannot be contacted it was requested that Detachment 2 send one man and one man only to Shelby, Iowa, to perform the investigation.
