14 COMMENTS A check with the personnel at COG Weather indicated that at the time of the sighting the winds were blowing FROM the south, north, and east, and at intervals between these directions. In the opinion of the observers this object could not have been a balloon because of the winds, but winds could have accounted for the sighting being a balloon. A preliminary report from the E6 ADiv indicated that the object was a weather balloon.
