

II. SUMMARY: Unidentified Flying Objects were sighted by COC Observer at Harrisburg, Pa, en 12 July 1955 as well as en previous eccassions. As directed by Headquarters 4602d AISS per telephone conversation, 13 July 1955, a telephonic investigation was conducted by Flight 3F to determine reliability of SOURCE. SOURCE was interviewed by telephone on 13 July 1955 and her immediate USAF supervisor was contacted and questioned regarding her reliability on 15 July 1955. This reliability report is a result of interviews with SOURCE AND with source's immediate USAF supervisor. The Commanding Officer of the 648th AC&W Squadron, which made all of the preliminary UFOB reports in these cases, and the officer who had conducted the preliminary investigation were contacted but neither could give any infermation regarding SOURCE'S reliability.
