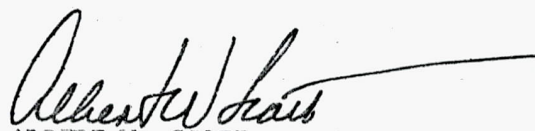

Major Horton, Hamilton Flight Service, Hamilton AFB, San Rafael, California, reported to Hill Air Force Base authorities on Friday evening, 2 September 1955, that a [REDACTED], in company with three other men, allegedly witnessed a "flying saucer" in the sky at approximately 80,000 feet between St. George and Cedar City, Utah. Only one of the four witnesses were interviewed by this office concerning this matter and his account appears reliable up to a certain point. [REDACTED] stated that he had a "mental conversation" with the object, (See Incl 1) and also stated that [REDACTED] also received mental telepathic waves of some sort from the flying object. However, he stated that the two other witnesses did not receive any communication from the object.
