The attached pastel drawing was rendered by Mr.


a commercial artist of this city. The drawing is intentionally a rough sketch since it was not possible to get more than an impression of the objects.

In Mr. opinion the objects were at least one fourth of a mile away, how much further he couldn't guess. They remained in view for perhaps three or four seconds and were moving rapidly in a westerly direction. There was no accompaning sound.

As I told you on the phone, Mr. was hunting at the time about three miles west of Lakeport, California. The date was July 22, and the hour 6 a.m. The morning was overcast as indicated in the sketch. None of the other members of the hunting party saw the objects.

I advised Mr. to make the drawing because I felt that it might serve a useful purpose. He is a sincere, highly skilled artist and trained observer. Because of this I am sure his drawing is a reasonably accurate reproduction of what he saw.

Mr would appreciate the return of his drawing after it has been appraised. For that purpose his business card has been attached to the drawing. If possible, we would also like an explanation of the objects seen.
