1. Long-distance telephone conversation between Mr. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] Pueblo, Colorado and Lt. Machyowsky of this Headquarters.
2. Lt. Machyowsky explained that his organization was responsible for the preliminary investigation for evaluation of UFOB sightings in the United States.
3. Lt. Machyowsky stated that he understood Mr. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] had witnessed two UFOB sightings within the last three hours.
4. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that was correct.
5. Lt. Machyowsky proceeded to interview the witnesses in order to collect information for an initial UFOB report. AFR 200-2 was used as a guide.
6. Lt. Machyowsky asked the witnesses to complete an ATIC Form for each sighting which would be forwarded to them as soon as possible.
