- 4. The initial ACWRON report was phoned into the ACWRON by the SCURCE. He claimed others saw the same sighting. ACWRON took his word and passed the report on.
- 5. The only witnesses, is statement regarding other witnesses, is that approximately 60 days prior to this event, several vacationers reported seeing a strange light in the sky. A check with State Police Post at Cadillac, Michigan revealed that the police investigated the vacationer's report and closed the investigation as solved with cause as bright star, probably Mars.
  - 6. Thus, there were no other witness to SOURCE'S sighting.

- 1. Long-distance telephone conversation between Lt. Wuerthner and Lt. Machyowsky of this Headquarters.
- 2. Lt. Machyowsky directed Flt 3-C to accomplish a limited investigation of the Beulah, Michigan UFOB sighting. (23/0450Z Oct 56)
- 3. Lt. Machyowsky suggested that the following steps should be followed in completing the investigation:
- a. Interview Mr. Sutton telephonically and get a description of the sighting and the names of other witnesses.
- b. Check to see if information obtained from source and information given in the initial ACWRON report correlate.
- c. Check with the 752d ACWRON for any additional information they may have received which could explain the sighting.
- d. Check all pertinent agencies in the Michigan area for balloon releases, aircraft, blimps, etc.
- 4. Lt. Machyowsky suggested that the sighting may have been caused by a blimp, a balloon, or an optical phenomenon.
- 5. Lt. Machyowsky advised Lt. Wuerthner that in the event that 3-C could not come up with a fairly conclusive solution by means of the limited investigation, this Headquarters should be called immediately for further instructions.
- 6. Lt. Wuerthner stated he would comply with the instructions as soon as possible.
