- 1. The attached information pertaining to an Unidentified Flying Object Investigation is submitted as requested.
- 2. The initial report, TWX INT-8-43, Comdr 662d ACWRON, Brookfield AF Sta, Ohio indicated that S/Sgt Strates Coulourianes observed the UFOB as well as Dr. and Mrs However, after centacting Sgt Coulourianes, it was found that he was the NCO en duty at the time the report was received at the Canton GOC Center, Ohio. He stated that he did not see the object, and that he only forwarded the report from the Dector to the 662d ACWRON.
- 3. Telephene calls to ATIC for astronamical conditions and balloom track information showed no possibility for a sighting within the UBCB area.
- 4. Telephone calls to the 662d ACWRON and the Canton GOC Center for information pertaining to aircraft and other known objects revealed no tracks or flight plans for the area at the time of sighting.
- 5. ATIC Form 164 was completed by Dr. and Mrs and forwarded to this unit as requested. This information is inclosed with this DF.
- T/Sgt Stone conducted the investigation, via phone and mail. No personal contact was made.
