- 1. In compliance with the attached request from the Air Technical Intelligence Center it is directed that your Flight conduct a complete investigation of the sighting described in the attached correspondence.
- 2. One member of Flight 3-A will proceed on a VOC to Paris, Illinois, by government vehicle as soon as practicable. AF Form 626 is to be submitted by your Flight.
- 3. Inasmuch as this sighting has received publicity through the Telonic Research Center, a civilian UFOB organization, a great amount of discretion must be employed by the investigator to prevent any repercussions on the USAF. and this organization.
- 4. In addition to the sighting in question it would be wise to ascertain the particulars of all of Mr. related sightings. The SOURCE should be satisfied that the USAF is extending every effort to determine the cause of his sightings. It is suggested that the investigator complete another ATIC Form 164 with the SOURCE

- 5. Although this headquarters is not aware of any bomber-parasite pickup operations in the area of the sighting it would be worthwhile to contact Chamte AFB to check out this theory. Other leads may be developed during the same contact. Another possibility would be an air-to-air Moby Dick balloon pickup by C-119 aircraft although this would not be a recurring phenomenon.
