In interview Mr. M. Va., supplied the following information: At approximately 2100 hours, 15 March 1949, de observed a disc-shaped yellowish, glowing object which appeared to be 18" in diameter at an estimated distance of 20 miles. This object moved across the sky from northeast to southwest at an angle of 45° above the horizon being in sight for two or three seconds and emitted a long, yellowish, tapering trail of flame. It stated that again on 28 March 1949, he observed another object following the same route at a similar speed and altitule. Weather reports, Morgantown, W. Va., Municipal Airport for 15 and 28 March set forth. Morgantown, W. Va. Police Department records are negative regarding
