This investigation is prodicated upon a letter dated 29 November 1949 to District Office No. 18, OSI, from the Federal Bureau of Investigstion, Los Angeles. The pertinent part of this letter is quoted below:

"On Howesber 24, 1949, , motion pieture actor, telaphonically advised this office that on the previous aftermoon he had been playing golf at the Laksaide Country Club with overnoard talking about a magnetic redio the latter had in his possession and which he claimed had come from a flying disc which had crashed in New Mexico.
