SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Miss. reported sighting two "flying saucers" Friday afternoon, February 24, 1950, at approximately 1500 to 1530 hours, heading in a Westerly direction, maintaining equadistance between them at all times. Mrs. The tated, during personal interview with agent, this office, that to the best of her judgment, the objects were approximently throe quarters of a mile high at time of sighting, were flying in a vertical position (compared to an ordinary china saucer), were silver in color, and gave off a vapor trail similar to that given off by sky-writing planes, except not quite as dark in color. Mrs. Mrs. compared the speed of the objects to that of the normal speed of four engined planes seen recently by her in this vicinity. Mrs. stated that the two objects never did rise above the horizon, but merely faded into the distance, and further that the information contained in the attached newspaper article re the "zig-zagging" of one of the objects at time of its disappearance, was not correct. Mrs stated that only the vapor trail of the object appeared to zig-zag, or deviate from the straight and even pattern it had been making during its flights this peculiarity was observed just about the time the two objects disappeared from sight. The two objects produced a steady drone unlike the sound made by conventional aircraft. Mrs. Estated that her negro yard man, conventional aircraft. 
