

One silver white sphere much higher than a jet fighter estimated at 6000 feet was observed over Lake Kishkonoug, Wisconsin on same southwest heading as jet. The object turned 180 degrees becoming an ellipse during turn then spherical again as it entered into course to the northeast. Speed was estimated at five times that of the jet aircraft.



- l. One silver white sphere one half the wing span of a single jet fighter believed by observer to be F-80 at estimated 6000 feet was observed much higher than fighter (five times) and on same southwest heading. Shere turned 180° after apparently sighting jet aircraft and as it turned it became an ellipse then sperical again as it took up northeasterly heading and appeared to climb slightly as it disappeared. Speed was about five times that of jet aircraft and there was no sound other than that from the jet fighter. Negative trail or exhaust observed.
- 2. Time of sighting: 1800 CDST 28 Jun 52 (0100Z 29 Jun 52). Object was in sight for about ten (10) seconds.
- 3. Observation was made visually from surface without optical or other equipment.
- 4. Observer was on north shore of Lake KISHKONCUG, five miles SW of Fort Atkinson and thirty two miles SE of Madison, Wisconsin. (42° 58' N 88° 55' W).
- 5. Chicago, Illinois delayed telephoning his sighting until after a Chicago newspaper story on "Flying Saucers in Chicago Area". Observer insisted the jet aircraft was F-80 or F-80 type aircraft. No further information is available as to his reliability or experience.
- 6. Weather: Perfectly clear at time of sighting and with bright sun. TRUAX AND Weather reports the following: Clear, visibility 15 miles. Very unlikely conditions for temperature inversion. At 1900 CDST cumulus-nimbus was observed north of Madison. Winds aloft:


- 7. No known activity could account for objects change in appearance as it turned or its high speed in relation to the jet aircraft.
