Total of 16 objects observed. Objects moved in east to west behind each other at intervals ranging fm 3-15 mins. Total time of sighting was 1 hour, 15 minutes. The silver objects, about the size of an aircraft disappeared separately over the horizon. One object was larger and had a red light on top. At one time two of objects came together &				11.
