1. The device is a magnetometer for remote measurement of the strength of the earth's magnetic field. The sensing element being supported by a pendulus mounting shows that it measures the strength of the horizontal component of the earth's magnetic field.

2. It was probably carried to a high altitude by a balloon and then transmitted field strength measurements by telemetry to a ground station.

THAT IT MEASURES THE STRENGTH
OF THE HORIZONTAL COMPONENT OF
THE EARTH'S MAGNETIC FIELD.

IT WAS PROBABLY CARRIED TO
A HIGH ALTITUDE BY A BALLOON AND
THEN TRANSMITTED FIELD STRENGTH
MEASUREMENTS BY TELEMETRY TO A
GROUND STATION.
