2. Analysis of the photograph indicates that the photo was probably exposed inside of a building and through a glass window. The object in question is probably a reflection on the window from a light hanging from the ceiling. The inside of the shade creates an elliptical shape and the strong white area in the top central portion is the light bulb which also gives off a halation creating the "bump" on the top of this reflection.


1. Analysis of the movie film reveals nothing of an unusual nature. The film was poorly exposed and the panning was such that it is plausable to assume that a child was taking the pictures. There was also an indication of a light leak on certain portions of the film. The Air Intelligence Information Report was of no value as there was nothing in the film which even remotely resembled the objects mentioned in the report.
