The following, extracted from Capt Bracke's Report dated 16 July 1960, is quoted for your information:

At 0215 EST 17 July 60, S/Sgt Rodriguez, A.R., of the 785th Radar Sq. Findley AF Station, Findley North Dakota, called in message handed to him as follows:

Mr. Door the Civil Air Patrol was flying over Devils Lake N.D. on a heading of 120 degrees at 0509Z 17 July when he saw an unusual streak of light. This was full extent of message and Rodriguez was told that info would be reported on routine basis.
