





SUBJECT: Report of Unknown Object over Amityville L I

1. About 9:30 PM Friday, December 15th, 1961, the three following named boys appeared at my Hq., reporting sighting of unknown object over Amityville, and also prepared the enclosed map:-

They reported that at about 10:45 pM the night of Thursday, December 14th, 1961, the three boys were riding in a car at the Amityville Municipal Bathing Beach area, just having come from a DeMolay Meeting in Amityville, when the moticed a large light in the sky, just beyond a large building, formerly the Herald Tribune Fresh Air Fund Camp, just to the west of the Bathing Beach on the waterfront.
 - 3. Following herewith find report submitted by

"I man and I couldn't explain it either, so we turned around and went to Point C (on the map) to observe it better. The "light" just hovered in the air over the Bay.


At point C, it travelled at an enormous rate of speed. By the time we reached Point O - it travelled from X to Y in a matter of only a few seconds.

We ran from E to E. Here, Object stopped and hovered at Y. We were at B (E) and heard a sound that would send chills up and down your back.

Object turned now and we saw a perfectly shaped object (strange sound, similar to a high whine and a low whine, mounting in crescendo, in unison) with bright rays appeared at it's sides. As it entered the clouds, it turned extremely bright, enough to light up the entire cloud area around it. Within a split second, the thing disappeared heading south. Strange sounds continued after object disappeared.

Sound stopped a short time later. "

- 4. Investigation of these boys by my office, revealed they are all highly intelligent young men, attending Amityville High School. They have never before been involved in any prank in the Village. They are all of high class caliber, of good character, coming from fine parents. They first reported this incident to their High School Teacher, Mr. Ben Kurland, and he referred them to my office. I have no reason to disbelieve their story, as they aren't the type to make things up.
- 5. When they reported to Hq on December 15th, 1961, they were equipped with a camera and a pair of binoculars, and were dressed in warm clothing. They stated they are intended to stake out the area again, hoping to spot the "object. Have not heard from them since.
