DEPT PASS NASA AND DEFENSE

THIS MORNING IN DEPARTMENT FOREIGN AFFAIRS WITH PRESS PHOTO-
GRAPHERS AND CORRESPONDENTS PRESENT I PRESENTED TO FORMIN. ERIC
LOUW MOUNTED AND INSCRIBED FRAGMENT RECOVERED NEAR ALIWAL NORTH
FEB. 21 AND LATER IDENTIFIED AS PART OF COL. GLENN'S ATLAS ROCKET
BOOSTER. SECRETARY JOOSTE WAS WITH LOUW AND COUNSELOR RPT COUNSELOR
CLARK AND AIR ATTACHE MILLS ACCOMPANIED ME. TEXT JOINT FOREIGN
AFFAIRS/EMBASSY PRESS RELEASE FOLLOWS:

"ONE OF SPACE AGES MOST HISTORIC MEMENTOS WAS PRESENTED TO
SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT IN AN INFORMAL CEREMONY IN OFFICE OF
MINISTER FOREIGN AFFAIRS ERIC LOUW THIS MORNING BY U.S. AMBASSADOR
JOSEPH C. SATTERTHWAITE.

MEMENTO IS A FRAGMENT OF ATLAS ROCKET WHICH BOOSTED LT. COL.
JOHN GLENN INTO ORBIT FEBRUARY 20 AND LATER FELL NEAR ALIWAL NORTH
IN CAPE PROVINCE. ALL FRAGMENTS RECOVERED WERE SENT TO UNITED
STATES FOR ANALYSIS.

FRAGMENT PRESENTED THIS MORNING, ABOUT TWO FEET SQUARE, HAS BEEN
MOUNTED AND INSCRIBED BY UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT. REMAINING
FRAGMENTS OF BOOSTER ROCKET WERE GIVEN TO UNITED STATES BY SOUTH
AFRICAN GOVERNMENT.

IN THIS MORNINGS CEREMONY AMBASSADOR SATTERTHWAITE SAID HE WAS
PLEASED TO MAKE PRESENTATION IN APPRECIATION OF SOUTH AFRICA'S

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-2-164, AUGUST 31, FROM PRETORIA

EXCELLENT COOPERATION IN AMERICAS SPACE EFFORTS.

INSCRIPTIONS ON MISSILE FRAGMENTS FRAME READ:

"PRESENTED BY UNITED STATES OF AMERICA NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION.

THIS IS A FRAGMENT OF ATLAS BOOSTER WHICH LAUNCHED LT. COL. JOHN H. GLENN, JR. AND MERCURY SPACE CRAFT "FRIENDSHIP 7" FROM CAPE CANAVERAL, FLORIDA, ON 20 FEBRUARY, 1962. THE ATLAS ORBITED EARTH FIVE TIMES AND TRAVELLED APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY THREE THOUSAND MILES. THIS FRAGMENT SURVIVED RE-ENTRY AND WAS RECOVERED NEAR ALIWAL NORTH, REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA, ON 21 FEBRUARY, 1962."

MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, IN THANKING AMBASSADOR FOR THIS RECOGNITION OF ASSISTANCE AFFORDED BY SOUTH AFRICA IN UNITED STATES PROGRAM OF RESEARCH IN OUTER SPACE GAVE ASSURANCE THAT SUITABLE ARRANGEMENTS OF A PERMANENT NATURE WOULD BE MADE FOR EXHIBITING FRAGMENT TO THE PUBLIC."

FRAGMENT WILL BE EXHIBITED INITIALLY AT PRETORIA-TRANSVAAL SHOW NOW IN PROGRESS.
