Appeared to be a couple of miles East of his home and traveling in NW direction. Visible about 1 minute approx. 9:42 PM. Disappeared as though someone turned lights off. Sky clear, no clouds. Searchlights in the area but this was much higher. Traveled much faster than any airplane.
