On the 15th of July press wires carried the details of the sighting of a mysterious glowing object which hovered near Canberra airport while the U. S. Mariner space probe was taking pictures of Mars. The initial story said that the object "has baffled experts in Canberra". The object was spotted by air traffic control officers and other expert aircraft observers on the 15th, at 10:50 a. m.

Six members of the traffic control tower told the press that the object "hung suspended" at about 5,000 feet for 40 minutes and that when the sun glinted on it, it became perfectly visible. It disappeared when an Air Force plane was sent out to identify it.

In the initial press story, experts were quoted as "wondering if it was coincidence" that the object was sighted shortly before nearby Tidninbilla tracking station was scheduled to pick up Mariner signals. The station, the report said, had unusual difficulty in locking on to Mariner at the time.

Dear Dr. Hynek,

I would like to report the sighting of a UFO on the night of July 15 at 9:55 till 10:30 Approximately.

Three boys plus myself, were lying on a rock ledge listening to a baseball game, when I was looking towards the big dipper and noticed an object moving slowly, thinking this was an old Echo Satellite I motioned to where it was and said, "Look, there's an Echo satellite!"

I first noticed it as it headed east between the second star on the handle of the big dipper and the third star. As we're surrounded by low mountains, the big dipper was low in the Northwest.

As we traced its path along the stars keeping it parralell or perpindicular to star clusters & parts of donstellations, we noticed that it changed its path twice. First, towards the Southeast and then East again. Everytime it changed its course, it would stop for about five seconds before continuing.

As it was twenty degrees (approximately) from the horizen, it stopped. At this time we could see it change colors from yellow to red to yellow to red, ect, like an airplane beacon at an airport but sometimes slow and sometimes fast.

As we watched it there, hovering, for ten minutes, we saw it grow a little dimmer. I suggested that we go home for my telescope and bring it back.

We ran the ½mile to my house in 3 minutes and I took the car back to the ledge. When we got there, the object was still there but going dim. I tried to get a fix on it but it had already grown dim and my sight on my telescope was off as I haven't used it in nearly six months.

As we left the ledge, the object was still in the same place ut was very, very dim.

Could you explain this to me? Four pairs of eyes don't lie!

BAGKERUUND:

The report was carried in the "Ferald News"(e), Fall River, Mass. dated 7/21/5. A personal interview was objected to because so many callers including the press, 3 NICAP members and a local UFO Group had already phoned ber. I did interview her by phone and she filled out a NICAP report form which I have enclosed.

SIGNTING ACCOUNT # 1:

The object sighted at 10:30 PH was a self-luminous light source comparable in size to a bright star. It was observed travelling on a straight course with a speed slower than an aircraft from a 70° elevation in the west to the southern horizon where it was obscured by distant trees. The unusual features about the object were that it carried no blinking aircraft identification lights and it moved along with a distinct "bouncing" motion. It was not resolvable through binoculars.

SIGNTING AGGUUNT # 2:

The object was sighted at 2:00 AM EDT 15 - 20° above the western horizon. The witness, curious about her first sighting was awake observing the western sky. (Her bedroom has a screen door which opens onto a sum deck giving her an unobstructed view of the western sky.) She noticed a reddish ster where it had not been earlier. She went out on the sum deck to get a better look at it. Observing the object through binoculars she noted that the object seemed to have a stationary center of yellow light, a stationary green light and a red light which rotated around the object. She positioned it on a fixed object and ascertained that it was hovering. After waiting accord minutes she then saw the object begin to move slowly with a distinct bouncing motion on a straight course toward the north where it disappeared out of line-of-sight bebind distant trees.

EVALUATION:

During both sightings the sky was clear and many stars were visible. No moon was noticed. (It had risen at 12:22 in the east). No transits of the Boho and Pegasus satellites were due at the UFO sighting times. The witness has a private pilot's license and is familiar with aircraft. The "bouncing" motion and hovering aspect are typical UFO characteristics. I felt that because of these factors, the caliber of the witness and the many other UFO sightings in this general area in July warranted a report to BIGAP.

newspaper accounts

The full account of these above-mentioned incidents occupies a full page i in each of four consecutive editions of the Buenos Aires newspaper "Cronica," (9/24/65-9/27/65), and space permits us to give here only the first of the incredible series of events. On the night of July 15th, while driving home from the Hotel De La Entrada, the Busquets family made a sighting described as follows: "It was a very large object, very luminous, bluish in color; but the color varied at times to orangish-red. It was quite near us. It had the shape of a short cone, although we could not see clearly where its upper part ended, as its surface was engulfed in a haze which was being emitted from on top. The bottom part was circular and convex. Taking the nearby hills as a reference, we estimated that it was 10 to 15 meters (yards) in diameter. In a moment we too were engulfed in a luminous haze. The object remained stationary, and no noise was heard.... After a long moment, it descended below a nearby hill, and the ground hid it, but we continued seeing the light it produced. Finally the light went out completely. We then continued our journey to the ranch, where we found that the laborers had seen it also."
