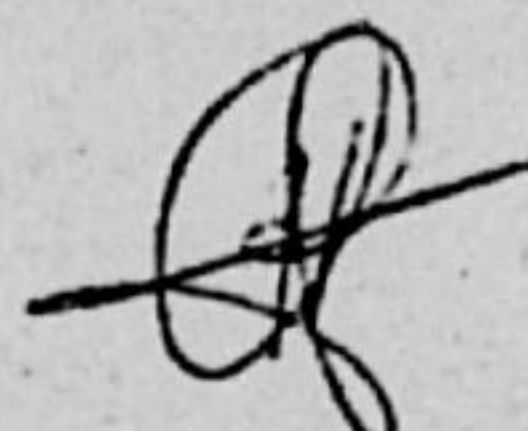

I never thought I would ever see a "UFO" and really was never sure they existed. However; My wife, her brother, his wife and myself saw ten 7en of them the night of March 17, 1966. It was about 9:00 p.m. and too dark to distinguish their shapes. All we could see was the two red lights on each one. (only one of the lights blinked.) The lights were about 15-20 ft. apart and the craft were about 25-30 ft apart and flying in a crooked Snake like formation. Since then several people have reported seeing them. 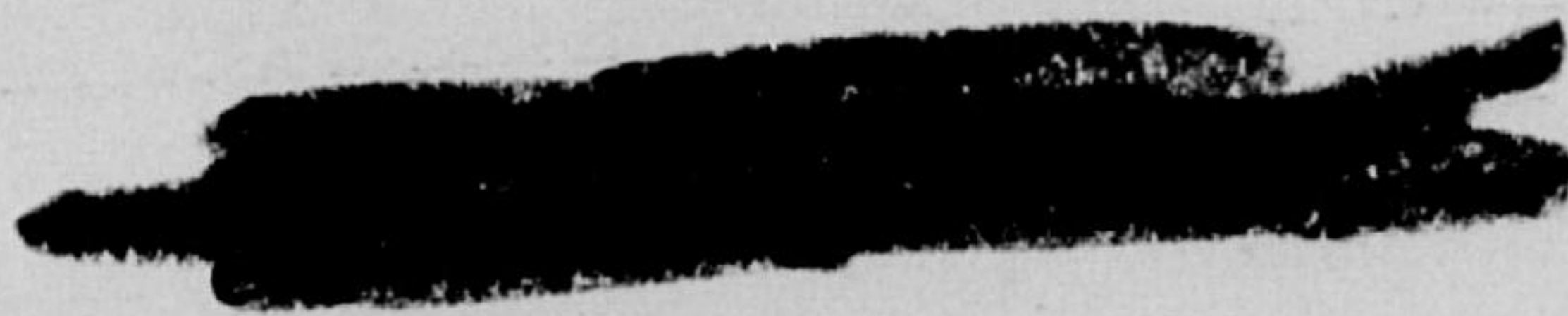
We are very interested in finding out all we can about these sightings and would appreciate any help you have to offer.
