

EYE WITNESS REPORT OF UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT STORTING At Dallas, Texas. September 28, 1966

"I saw a Miscwahared (. F. O. above my home in the Fleasant Grove area in the Southeastern part of Dallas, wednesday night, September 23, 1966, beginning at 11:35 P. M. I was not sleepy so I got out of red to get a drink of water in the kitchen. I glanced out the window and a britht light caught my eye. I ran outside in my pajamas and noticed the light seemed to be flashing, in a moment I could see there were four or five lights prouped together and the remainder of the circumference had three other brights lights about equally-spaced. This revolving of the lights gave the aspearance that thet were flashing. On top of the disc was a red dome barely visible. It wont directly over my house moving southward with a dipping motion. I saw it very clearly and it seemed at its lowest dip when I first spotted it. It definitely was not an airplane, belieupter, balloon, or weather phenomenon; it was a disc snaped maneuverable object. I am not an extert at judging height, speed or size but I would estimate that it was about 300 to 400 feet above the ground when lasting over my house and 30 to 40 feet in diameter moving 70 to 80 miles an hour. I watched wo it wo southward and turn in a banking turn toward the wast and southwest of Dallas. It went almost out of my vision as it was directly to the west of my house. I ran through my house, calling to my wife to watch it with me from the frontward. It had awakened her with its loud humming sound as it passed over my house. I also heard a humming sound about the same as a generator will make. We both rotted it directly west of Dallas downtown area, and it was making another bank turning to the east and coming back toward us. It seemed to dip slightly as it came directly overcallas and about halfway back to our house and then turned back to the north, northwest and went out of sight. I watched it for about ten or fifteen minutes and my wife watched it with me for about half that long. All of the lights except the dome were white. The moon was almost full and there were no clouds in the sky. It was a beautiful night.
