- 1. In accordance with AFR 200-2, the following information regarding UFO's is submitted.
- 2. UFO's were sighted by Mrs. from 2325 on 17 Oct 66 to 0245 on 18 Oct.
  - a. Description of the objects:
- (1) Ten of the UFO's were reported as being "donut-shaped." However, the observer said that she could not see through the object, but they appeared to be hollowed out in the center. The eleventh UFO was described as a circle of white light.
- (2) The objects were larger than the lights on passing airliners.
- (3) The donut-shaped UFO's were alternately red, yellow, and green. The sphere of light was white.
  - (4) Eleven UFO's were sighted.
- (5) (See attached diagram drawn by Mrs. for flight paths of the UFO's.)
  - (6) See item (1).
- (7) The first UFO, referred to by Mrs. as the "mother ship", reportedly shot out a flash of green light.
  - (8) No sound was heard.

- j. Observer reported three aircraft passing from NW to SE at 0545Z, 0715Z, and 0745Z.
- k. Comments of investigating officer: Sightings could have resulted from aircraft lights, satellites, or stellar formations. No other sightings were reported from this particular area, although there has been a rash of colored light sightings in the Tampa-St. Petersburg area of late. Local astronomers have pointed out that people are most likely seeing Canopus, the second largest star visible from earth, and the planet Jupiter.

1. The observer furnished the investigating officer with a diagram showing the movement of the objects sighted. The observer also prepared a key to explain the diagram. Annotations made by the investigating officer to further clarify the diagram are noted with an asterisk.


