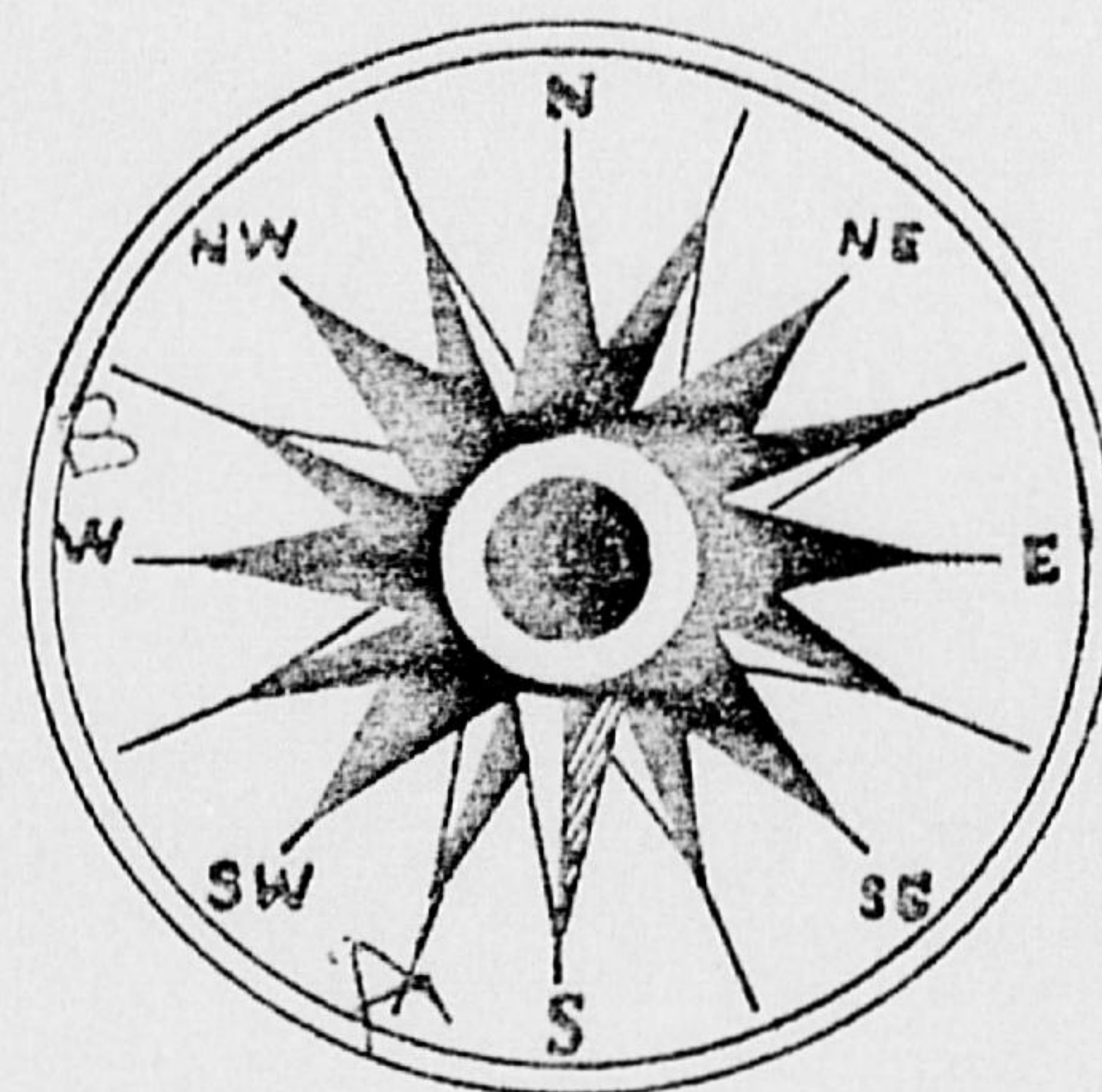
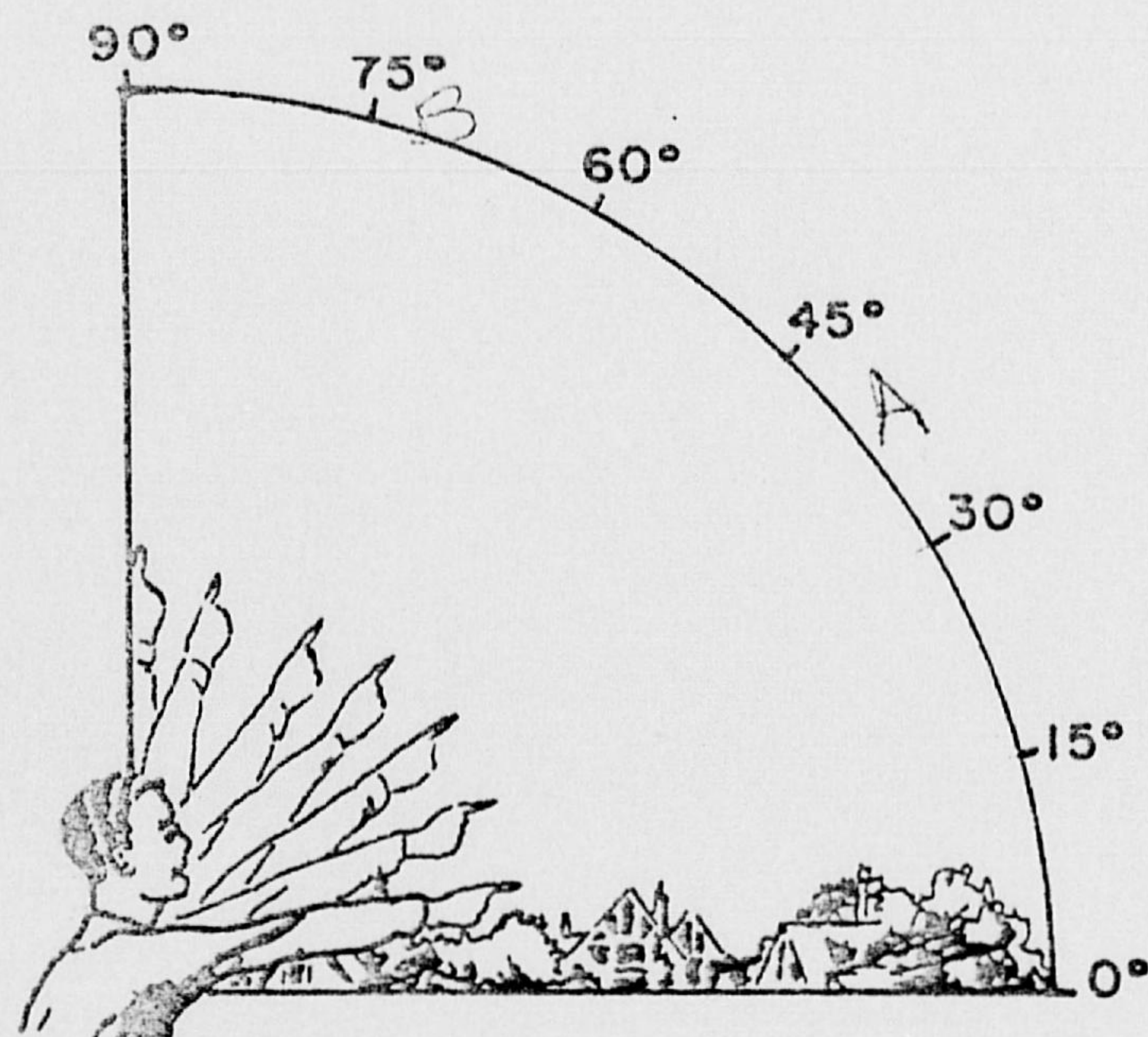

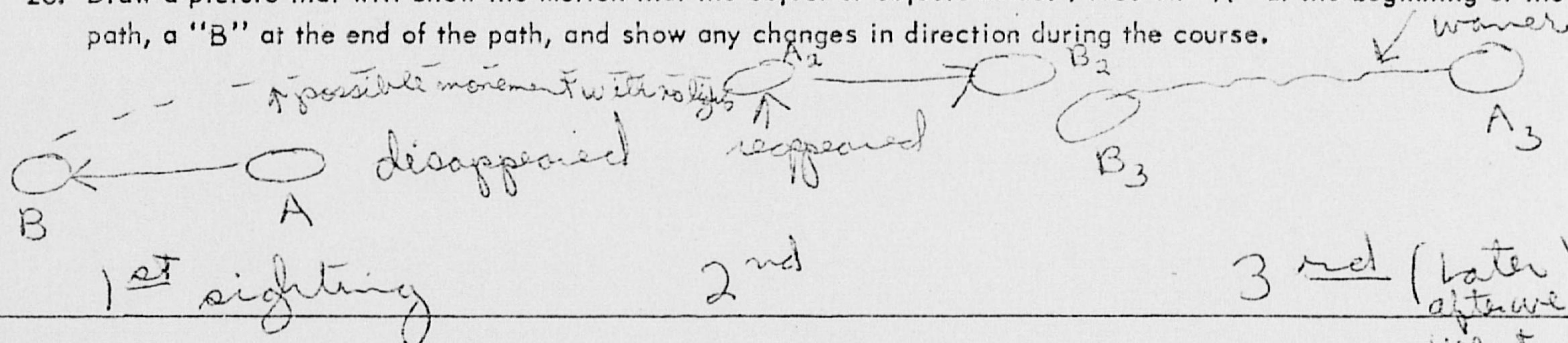

When we 1st saw it, it was blinking red and white lights with 2 bright lights (white) that revolved on the top row.

It appeared to have 2 stories. A plane went over and the lights dimmed. They stayed dim for 30 sec. or more after the plane went by. Then it disappeared. It reappeared higher up and traveled to the right. We went in the house. Later we went out again and it came by the house quite close.

It appeared as 2 red lights at the front. These were not blinking and quite some distance apart. At the rear was a white light, up higher. There was no sound of noise whatsoever. It had a floating motion and wavered slightly as it moved. My 2 very young children saw it

too, but they are too young to be
witnesses.
