
"A flying saucer killed them," Territorial Policeman Arthur White said flatly when interviewed last week by MIDNIGHT. "We have the evidence to prove

The bodies of Hayden, 35, and his 30-year-old wife were found in the kitchen of their ranch home near Borroloola in Australia's vast and lonely Northern Territory after DEREK HAYDEN (above) "an enormous shimmering were light" hovering in the vicinity.

"The light passed over my house at about 11:20," neighboring rancher Frank McCullough, 50, told MID-NIGHT. "It was moving slowly so I got a good look

at it. "My wife and six other people who work for mehere saw the thing. It was no dream. We all saw it."

McCullough said he and the others watched the object for more than five minutes

"But like they'd seen something so shocking and disgusting that they couldn't stand it. It's hard to describe their expressions but I hope I never see anyone with that look again.

"There were no cuts, bruises, or other marks on the victims - and no indications of a struggle in the room.

"A collie dog belonging to Mr. Hayden was also found dead in the room. It was stretched straight out the same as Mr. and Mrs. Hayden. There were no marks of violence on the dog. It's teeth were bared as though it were growling when it died."

Inspector Owen made a second gruesome discovery outside the ranch house. extending 1,000 yards around the house was dead.

"I found 22 dead cows, two cats, and an uncounted number of birds, gophers, snakes and the like. Everything was unmarked but very, very dead."







Captain A whom I have met here at the Martin Marietta Corporation in Baltimore, has asked me to write you regarding a UFO sighting by me on the night of February 3, 1968.

I was flying a Lockheed JetStar at 33,000 feet and indicating Mach 0.82. The weather was clear with unrestricted visibility. A beam HUF a light was observed at three o'clock and higher than my flight. A guess would put it fifteen or twenty thousand feet higher. At first, the light appeared to resemble a flight of two aircraft in trail. The light moved at a high rate of speed, at a steady course and altitude. My heading was 87° so I would guess its heading was about 50°.

As it passed at 12 o'clock, they definitely appeared as two distinct light sources. Each light source emitted that I would describe as a pencil beam of light. This beam had no taper, did not trail off but maintained a constant cross section and ended abruptly. I would describe it as whitish in color changing to phosphorescent. The changes in color were subtle and did not appear modulated.


When these lights moved to 1100 o'clock the front light seemed to be outdistancing the rear light. The rear lights at this angle appeared as two distinct lights of the same intensity and both also trailed by identical pencil beam of light. A few seconds later, it all disappeared from sight because of the distance from my position.


The time was approximately 1045 p.m. EST. My course was a doppler track from PWE direct to IND. Drift was six degrees right. The total time this was observed was between 40 and 50 seconds. All this observation is as it was actually witnessed and my copilot concurs with everything as it is stated here.

I compare this with meteorites, missile re-entries and satellites I have seen and am certain this is none of these. I hope this information is helpful to you. I made a complete report to IND center and heard perhaps a half a dozen air carrier pilots make similar reports.

Drop me a line when you compare this and next time I am in Denver, I would enjoy a chat with you.


