

UFO Sightings of Aug 1967 and 8 Jun 1968



Reference your UFO sightings of Aug 1967 and 8 Jun 1968. Although we consider these sightings too old to investigate properly, we did submit your photographs to our photographic experts. Their findings are as fallows:

"There is a definite pattern of light imagery on both prints. There are at least five of these images in addition to the particular one on each print identified by the sender as a UFO. An overlay was constructed for print Nr. 1 with tick marks over each image including that identified as a UFO. When this overlay was applied to print Nr. 2, the tick marks correspond perfectly to the images present. Due to the fact that there is a definite pattern of like images although the field of view differs considerably, it is most likely that there was a pattern of foreign material present on the negative holder of the printing device.

An overlay was constructed for print Nr. 1 with tick marks over each image including that identified as a UFO. It was on June 8th 1968 when my friend and I saw a FLYING SAUCER, (U.T.D.). It was a round object with different colors. It looked like this, example.






