

20 September 1968

6:05 AM EDT

10-15 min duration

Sighted 7 white lights about mag. of 1st mag. stars due west at about 20 elevation. The lights traveled from SW to NE and disappeared over the horizon in about 10-15 min. There was no noise and observer decided they weren't high flying aircraft because he could see no vapor trails. The angular velocity was that of Echo I.

Sunrise occurred at 6:56 AM EDT. (JAH)
