Without additional information, we cannot offer an explanation of what you saw. However, if you will complete the inclosed questionnaire and mail it in the attached envelope, our technical people at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, will e able to investigate further and make an evaluation. Should you ever sight another unidentified flying object (UFO), please report it as soon as possible to the nearest Air Force unit. The nearest one to Delmar is the 656th Radar Squadron at Smratoga Air Force Station; if you will call the Station and ask for the UFO investigator at either Extension 251 or 252, someone will take your report. The local UFO investigator, who is in a better position to make an on-the-spot investigation, is usually able to achieve a more accurate analysis.
