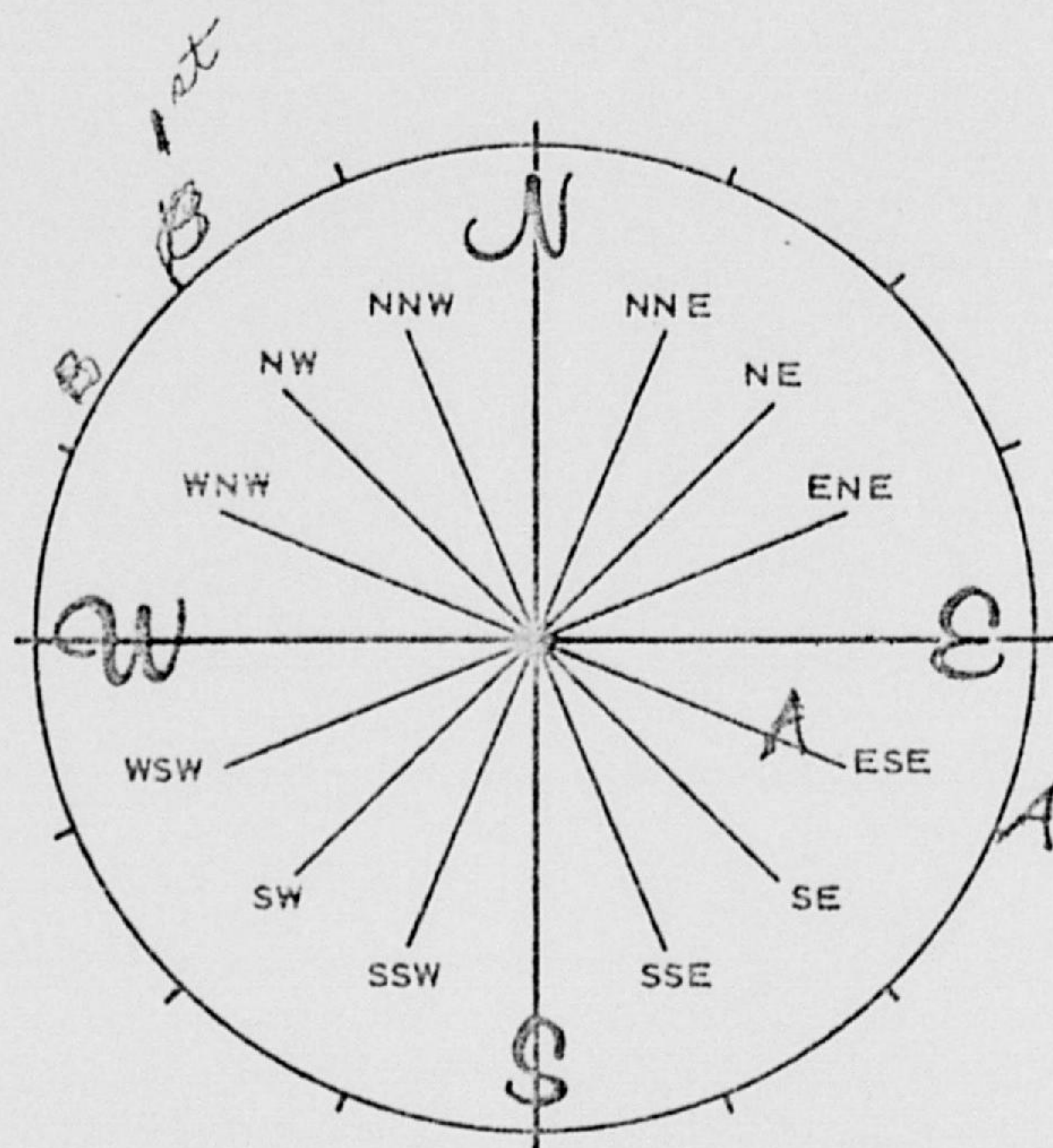

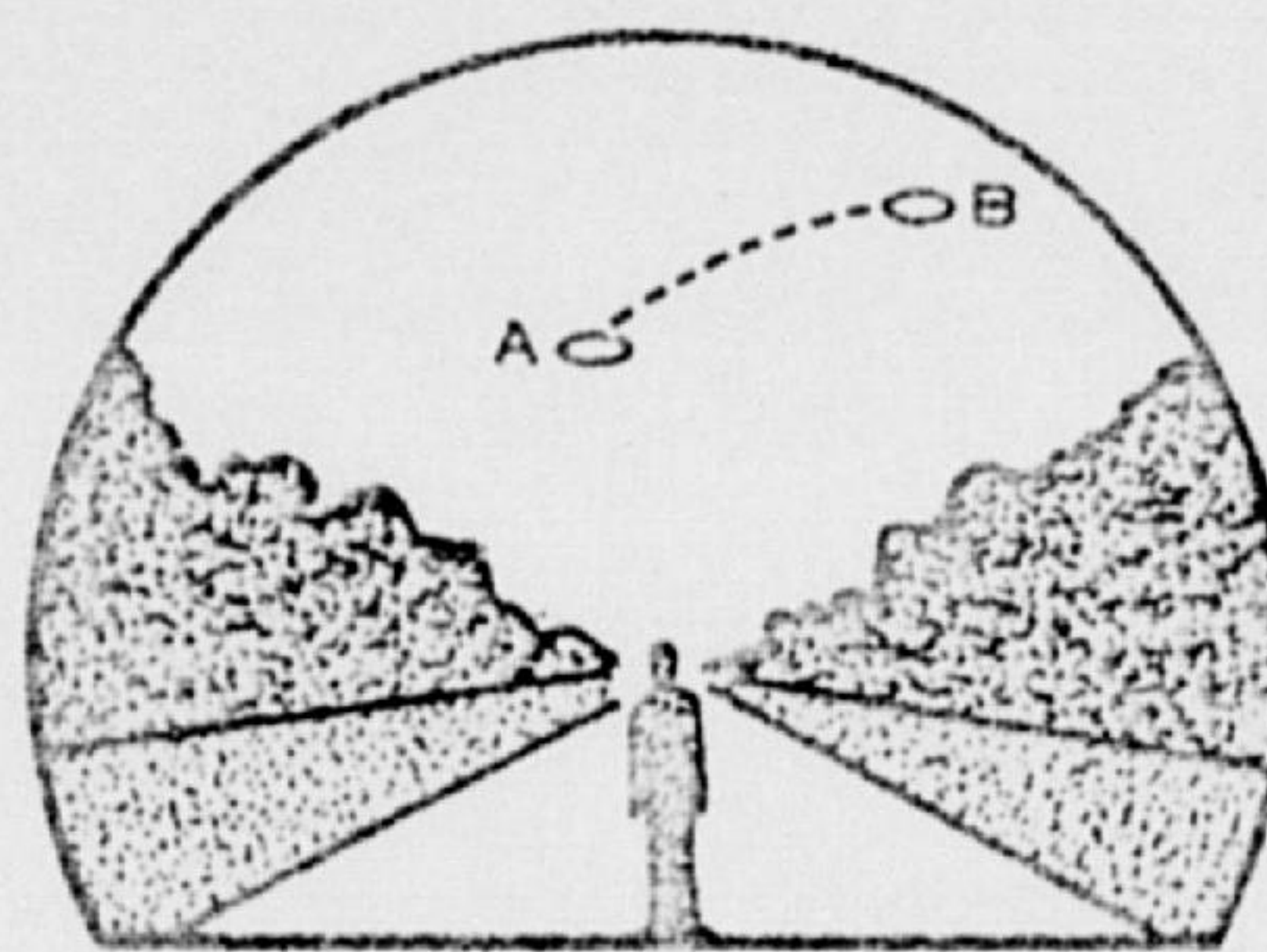
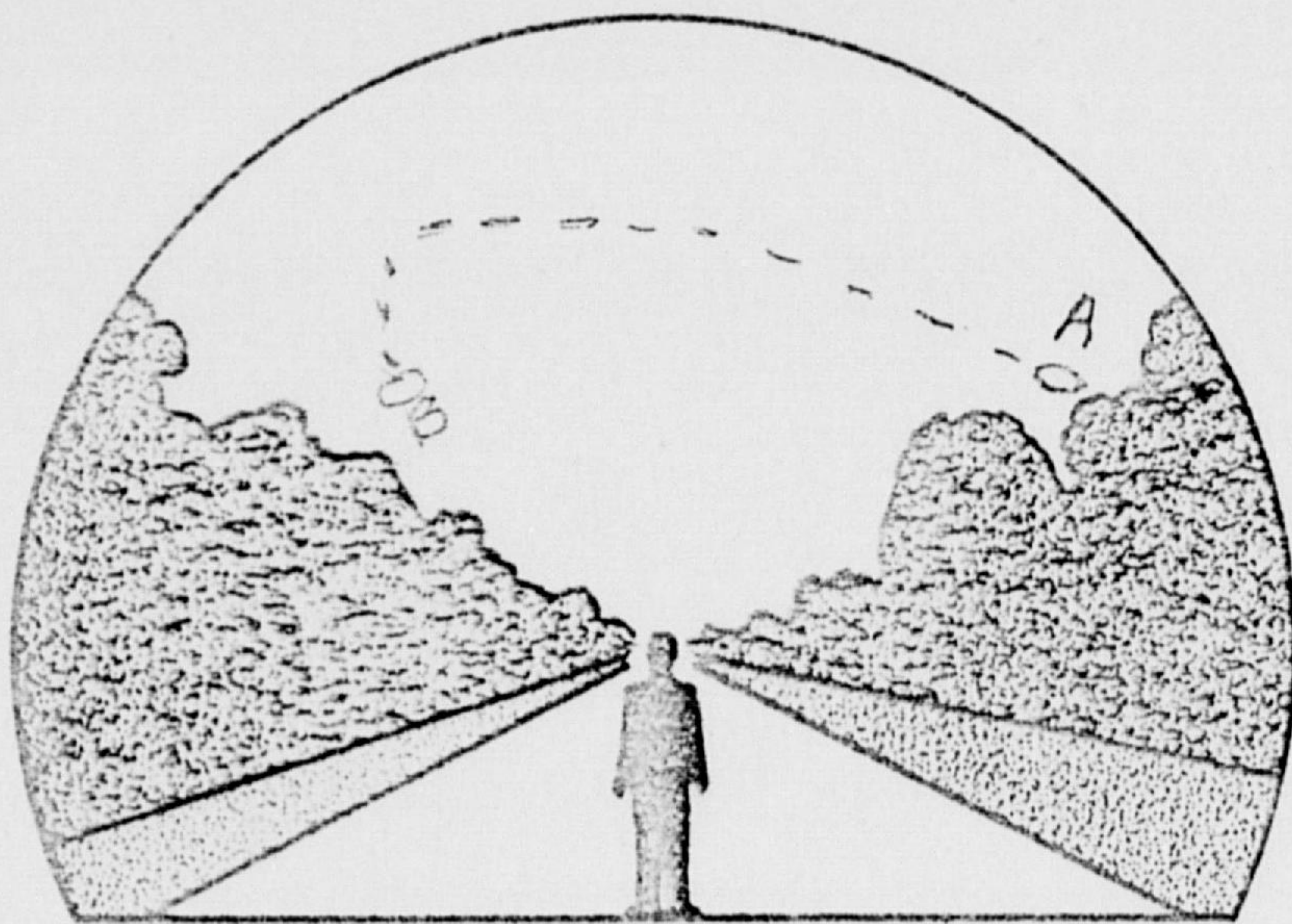

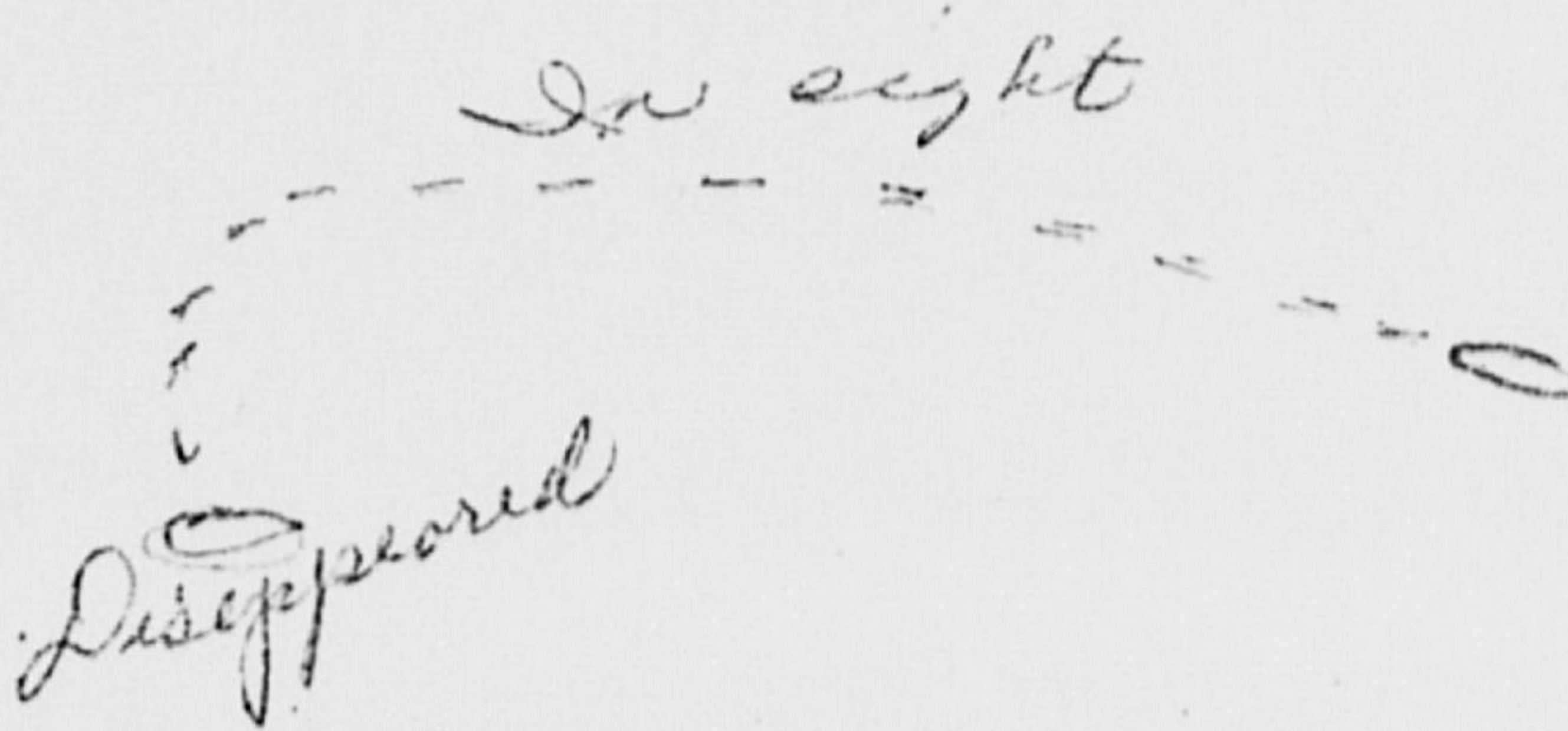

1. On 22 Sep 69, the Aerial Phenomena Office received a telephone call from Mrs. [REDACTED] regarding a UFO observation. On 22 Sep 69 at 1430 hours, Mrs. [REDACTED] observed a shiny object in the SE moving to the NW. The object was at a 75° angle. She observed the object for about 15 seconds. The object came from the SE, turned, then disappeared into nowhere. The sky was clear. The object was smaller than a dime at arms length.
2. The observer stated she is very interested in UFO's. She had her dark glasses in her pocket. She carries them with her at all times so the sun will not interfere if she sights an object. She usually carries her binoculars also, but she didn't have them with her at the time of this sighting. The observer stated that she looks for these objects. She has seen quite a few objects (mostly at night), but this is the best one of all.
3. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she saw another UFO about 2 weeks ago, but she didn't report it. She asked for the number at which she could reach us directly so she won't have to waste any time contacting us the next time she sights an object.
