154225 A.C. - NORTH AMERICAN F-100 SUPER SABRES of the 479th Fighter Day Wing,  
George AFB, Calif., lined up on base flight ramp. The 479th was  
the first Air Force wing to receive the new supersonic fighter.  
Second to get the first of the "Century" series of fighters was  
the 450th Fighter Day Wing at Foster AFB, Texas, which is now  
flying the second of the Super Sabre versions, the F-100C. The  
F-100, which holds the official world speed record, can exceed  
the speed of sound in level and climbing flight and is the Air  
Force's first supersonic fighter to become operational.
