In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act, 44 U.S.C. 2201, the regulations promulgated thereunder, 36 C.F.R. 1270.46 and Executive Order 12667, this letter is our formal notice to the incumbent President of our intent to open selected Reagan Presidential records on November 7, 1994.

In response to a Freedom of Information request (NLS F94-043) submitted by Lee M. Graham the records proposed for opening consist of approximately 167 pages of material relating to UFO's and the "Operation Majestic 12" document. This material has been reviewed for the six PRA restrictions that President Reagan imposed and the four remaining FOIA restrictions. President Reagan's representative, Cathy Busch, is also being notified of this proposed opening.

In accordance with the requirements stated in Executive Order 12667, a final review has been conducted for any materials that might raise a "substantial question of Executive privilege" if opened. The final review has been completed and the Reagan Library staff has not identified any items within the material proposed for opening that might raise a "substantial question of Executive privilege," as defined in Executive Order 12667.

Pursuant to section 2(b) of EO 12667, we intend to disclose the above described Presidential records on November 7, 1994 unless we receive an objection or claim of privilege from your office.
